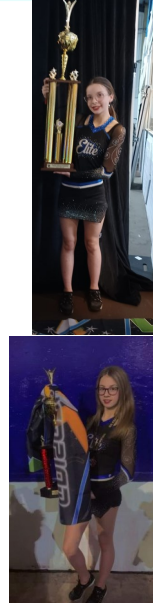
## Rory school dog update
