Extra-Curricular PE Activities for Autumn Term 1

I am writing to inform you of the new term extra-curricular clubs, which will be commencing on the week beginning 12th September. All sports clubs will start at 3.15pm and finish at 4.15pm, with the exception of **KS2 Girls Football** which will be **3:05pm-4:05pm**.

The school, with your help, want to encourage all children to engage in the extra-curricular clubs on offer. The clubs are designed to be fun but still provide key teaching points to maximise pupils' learning and in many cases may result in playing for the schools teams. We aim to continue to build upon the school's already impressive sporting achievements.

KS3 Boys Rugby club will be limited to 20 children, so places will be allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis. There will be a waiting list if the numbers go above 20 and if proving to be popular will be expanded after October half term.

Due to safety reasons Street Surfing will also be limited to 20 children. The same will apply, if the club proves to be popular we will rotate the students after October half term. All other clubs are limited to 30 children.

The clubs are open to all standards of ability and we are working hard to ensure there are a wide range of activities on offer for all year groups. Staff will do their very best to ensure that the clubs will run, but sometimes fixtures will have to take priority. Additionally, please be aware that in the event of adverse weather, resulting in a safety concern, a club may be cancelled on the day. We hope that this will be a rare occurrence and we will have fabulous weather throughout the term! We will do our best to give you as much notice as possible if a club is to be cancelled for that week by text. It is most important therefore that we have up to date contact details for you. We ask that you have alternative arrangements in place in case of cancellation on the day, otherwise children will be sent to After School Homework Club.

If the numbers exceed our limits, the children will be placed on a waiting list so that we can adapt the clubs appropriately.
