Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: TGBDO & Dance Live, Rehearsal Schedule, Costume, Transport, T-shirts and Hoodies and Tickets

I would like to update you with further information regarding The Great Big Dance Off for KS2 & KS3 and Dance Live for KS3. Rehearsals are underway in preparation for the competitions and both teams have been working extremely hard. As you can appreciate, time is now of the essence as both competitions are fast approaching! Below you will find detailed information regarding both competitions. This will include, important rehearsals which all participants must attend, costume, transport, itinerary, tickets and merchandise.

Costume KS2 & KS3 Items

All pupils will need to have the following items ready for our dress rehearsal. In order to make the costume process as simple as possible, we are asking parents / carers to provide a 'base' layer that can then be adapted, altered and transformed! Please can children bring the requested items in a named plastic bag.

- black dance / gymnastic shorts (ideally tight to the leg) please see image:
- black vest top
- black under wear (pants / boxers & bra / crop top)
- Black Jazz / gymnastic shoes (see picture). These can also be purchased from Decathlon and other stores. If pupils can start to bring these in for rehearsals, it would really help.









- Please could you pack the following items hairbrush & two hairbands.
- foundation with a sponge
- blusher and mascara
- red lipstick
- named coat hanger / bag

Food

Both competitions will be long and exciting days, we will be up against another a large number of exceptional schools in both heats. We need to ensure that the pupils stay energised and hydrated. Please can all children ensure they bring with them; lunch, snacks, dinner and plenty of water. There will not be a facility to heat food, so please do not provide your child with a meal which requires heating. They may also like to bring their own baby wipes to take off any make up on the trip home.

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Devices / valuables

Please do not send pupils with any devices or valuables. Phones are permitted, but they will be kept in a phone box with a member of staff.

TGBDO KS2 & KS3 - 27th February 2023:

Pupils will need to attend school in their PE kit on the 27th **February** and we will be leaving school via coach around 9:45 am.

Please can all pupils arrive at BMS for the start of the school day with all of their belongings including their snacks, lunch, dinner (we will not have provision to heat food), drinks (not fizzy or energy drinks), costume, dance shoes and hair and make-up accessories.
