All clubs will have a cap on numbers dependent on staff available for the club, however, we will endeavor to offer places to as many children as we can. If the numbers exceed our limits, the children will be placed on a waiting list so that we can adapt the clubs appropriately.

To ensure fairness, please only select one extra-curricular club per day of the week. If your child is unsuccessful in securing a place we will try to accommodate them at another club of their choosing where possible.

Please be aware that in the event of adverse weather (e.g. torrential rain/snow), a club may be cancelled on the day. This would be a last resort, as we will always try to cater for all clubs, but in this event, we will do our best to give you as much notice as possible. Therefore, please ensure that the School Office have up to date contact details. We ask that you have alternative arrangements in place in case of cancellation on the day, otherwise children will be sent to After School Homework Club.

As always, children are expected to follow all behavior expectations at clubs, as they do in school, and therefore, any repeated behaviour issues will result in their place being offered to another child.

Should your child be offered a place at an after-school club, please can you let the office know if they cannot attend for any reason. Likewise, if you are expecting your child to attend a club and they do not turn up to be registered, a WEDUC message will be sent as promptly as possible to inform you. If your child does not attend their club for three weeks on the run, without a valid reason, they will be taken off the register and their place will be offered to someone on the waiting list – you will be notified if they are taken off a club list.
