Dear Parent / Carers,

Extra-Curricular Clubs for Autumn Term

I hope you all had a wonderful break and are looking forward to the new school year as much as we are! As we come to the end of the summer holidays, I wanted to take this opportunity to welcome all the children back to school and provide information about extra-curricular clubs for the Autumn Term. We really want to encourage the children to develop their skills and talents or try something new!

After school clubs will start from the week beginning 11th September 2023; after school clubs run from 3.15pm until 4.15pm with the exception of Warhammer which finishes at 4.30pm. Below is the timetable for the Autumn Term, until the Christmas Holidays. Miss Curtis will also be launching the school show this half term and rehearsals will be on a Monday and a Thursday after school. More information will follow separately about this in due course.

Please sign your child up by clicking on the following link: https://forms.office.com/e/FZwPbiv6tV and we will let you know if your child has successfully secured a place. All clubs will have a cap on numbers, however, we will endeavor to offer places to as many children as we can. If the numbers exceed our limits, the children will be placed on a waiting list so that we can adapt the clubs appropriately. You do not need to sign up for the Warhammer drop in session on Friday lunchtime but there is a maximum of 10 spaces so this will be first come first served on the day.

Please be aware that in the event of adverse weather, resulting in a safety concern, an outside club may be cancelled on the day. This would be a last resort, as we will always try to cater for all clubs, but in this event, we will do our best to give you as much notice as possible. Therefore, please ensure that the School Office have up to date contact details for you. We ask that you have alternative arrangements in place in case of cancellation on the day, otherwise children will be asked to attend After School Homework Club during this time.

If your child would like to take part in an extra-curricular club, please complete the online form to book their place by the end of this week. After school clubs always have high demand, therefore we recommend completing this as soon as possible. We always expect the children to follow all behavior expectations at clubs, as they do in school, and therefore, any repeated behaviour issues will result in their place being offered to another child. If your child is offered a place at an after-school club, please can you ensure to let the school office know if they cannot attend for any reason.
