



School Uniform Policy

Parental support is required to ensure that all pupils are well presented. The standard of dress is important because it sets the expectation for work and behaviour and projects a positive image of the school in the community. It is expected that all pupils will take responsibility for their personal hygiene and arrive dressed in a clean, tidy and respectable manner. We ask parents to support the role in creating a sense of belonging to the school.

Shoes

Plain, ALL black, low heeled, smart leather school shoes.

Sandals, soft or canvas shoes, trainers, open backed shoes, boots and shoes with logos are not permitted.

Traditional school shoes will be issued if students wear anything other than sensible school shoes in school. Requests to wear anything other than the above for medical reasons must be accompanied by a signed doctor's note outlining the medical issue and timescales.
