Extra-Curricular PE Activities for the Spring Term

I am writing to inform you of the new term extra-curricular clubs, which will be commencing on the week beginning 13th January and end on the 27th March 2020. All sports clubs will start at 3.05pm and finish at 4.15pm.

The school, with your help, want to encourage all children to engage in the extra-curricular clubs on offer. The clubs are designed to be fun but still provide key teaching points to maximise pupils' learning and in many cases may result in playing for the schools teams. We aim to continue to build upon the school's already impressive sporting achievements. Please see the PE notice board for information about lunchtime clubs which will take place on the field.

The Year 5/6 Tag Rugby club and all years basketball club will be limited to 25 children. Both boys and girls are welcome to join, but it will be first come first served with replies coming back to the school office.

Please also note that hockey club will run on Tuesday 21st and 28th January, followed by Wednesday 12th and 26th February, 4th, 11th, 18th and 25th March. It will be placed on a Wednesday on the table.

We are also aiming to run a football club for Year 5s and information will follow in due course.

The clubs are open to all standards of ability and we have worked hard to ensure there are a wide range of activities on offer for all year groups. Staff will do their very best to ensure that the clubs will run, but sometimes fixtures will have to take priority. Additionally, please be aware that in the event of adverse weather, resulting in a safety concern, a club may be cancelled on the day. We hope that this will be a rare occurrence and we will have fabulous weather throughout the term! We will do our best to give you as much notice as possible if a club is to be cancelled for that week, either by letter or text. It is most important therefore that we have up to date contact details for you. We ask that you have alternative arrangements in place in case of cancellation on the day, otherwise children will be sent to After School Homework Club.
