**Year 6 SAT Preparation**

We are writing to inform you of some changes we will be making over the next few weeks in Year 6 to ensure the best possible outcomes for your children.

Following our recent mock SATs in February, we have spent some time analysing the data against the children’s predicted DFE (Department for Education) scores from KS1. We have looked at this data set alongside the question level analysis from the February mocks and have tailored the timetable provision over the next few weeks to ensure your child gets targeted teaching to maximise their potential.

Pupils have been allocated to a smaller targeted maths group. The maths groups will be run by all of the year 6 team plus other experienced teachers within the school. The structure of the sessions will be consistent to support the application of arithmetic and reasoning skills.

The children will be provided with tracker cards to understand where they are and where they need to get to, these will also run as an incentive and successful progress in weekly tests will result in a Friday treat each week. The cards will look similar to the example below and they will be encouraged to take these home and share with yourselves.
