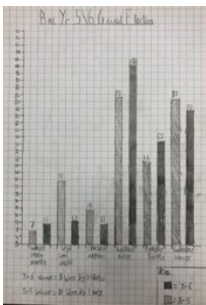


# SNAPSHOTS OF THE WEEK
