Year 6 Broadstone Community Clean-up

As part of our current module 'A life on our planet', our Year 6 pupils are learning about renewable and non-renewable resources and the role they can have in saving the future of the planet. To bring their learning together and have a positive impact on the environment, we have organised for our pupils to undertake a community clean-up at Broadstone recreation ground on Friday 26th September 2025.

We have carefully considered this visit with a thorough risk assessment and the safety aspects involved which will be discussed with the children beforehand. We will look at the resources found in the local community and use the data collected back in the classroom to continue the children's learning and compare our findings to our school clean-up data.

As the logistics of running a school trip require enough adult support, if you would like to volunteer to support us on the trip, please contact the school office as we would be very grateful for parent help. You would need to be available between 8:30am and 1pm. Unfortunately, if we do not have enough adult support, we will not be able to go ahead with the clean-up. Thank you to those who have already volunteered.

We ask that pupils wear their PE kit for the trip with long-sleeved tops and trousers so that they are appropriately dressed for the activities planned. If the weather is particularly wet that week, we would encourage children to wear walking shoes or wellies if they prefer. Please ensure that your child brings a coat and water bottle. Students will need to arrive at school at their normal time in the morning and will be back at school in time for the usual lunchtime arrangements and school finishing time.

If you have not already provided permission for your child to attend the clean-up by completing the online form using the link in the educational visits and experiences letter, please do so by using the link below by Monday 22nd September so that we can finalise arrangements.
